Hi Everyone! The folks at Spalding CSD just wanted to give you all an update of the past year's events and accomplishments. I started as General Manager for the District on December 28, 2009. Many things have changed since that time. We are in a new section of the CSD building with a much more user friendly space! A new maintenance shop has also been built to house our wastewater operation. All this was accomplished using the USDA funds and grants. They also provided us with a new computer server for the smoother operations of our overall network and wastewater monitoring.

Lake levels were very low during the 2010 fishing season, but with recent snow and rain storms, we are hopeful for the return of higher lake levels during the 2011 season. This will certainly help with the launching of boats from our Marina facility. Fees for launching will remain the same again this year and we have added two, three and five day permits for those staying for the week. Our wastewater system has been functioning very well. There are still a few property owners who have not hooked up and/or paid for operations and maintenance fees. We are doing whatever we can to encourage those folks to be a part of the system as soon as possible. We would also like to encourage the owners to check the filter on their septic tanks sometime during the year. An explanation of how to conduct the filter inspection is on our website under Wastewater.

The Fire Department has recently gone through a change in Chiefs. Our new Chief is John Rasnic. He brings some public safety knowledge and is going full bore to become trained in many areas of emergency management. John hopes to have his EMT certification by the summer and has been taking some fire management classes. John is a great addition to our ranks!
