Hi Everyone! Another winter is just about in the books and we are looking forward to our summer visitors and residents back to Spalding! The lake is low, but Pine Creek is running and we're hopeful for rain throughout the spring. We will do all we can to make sure that everyone has a positive recreational experience! Since the lake is so low, we are not going to start the sale of annual Marina use permits until May.

Sewer O&M fees can still be paid annually in July for \$300. There are currently over 100 customers utilizing the annual payment method and saving \$12.00 a year. Remember, quarterly the fee is \$78.

The Spalding Fire Dept. is doing a great job and responded to 28 calls for service last year. Our Fire Chief John Rasnic has resigned and moving to Redding to take a position with the State. We thank Chief Rasnic for his service and wish him and his family well in their new location! Fundraising efforts for the Ambulance are still ongoing. We're still about \$2,000 short and are hoping for the community's continued support. The Fire Department still needs your donations! Also, any person who has special needs and wants to make our Fire Department aware, there is a form on the website to fill out, sign and return. It will be kept on file. All personal information is kept confidential but beneficial to first responders in case of an emergency.



If you haven't visited our website lately, there are many changes and additions that you might find interesting. We have added a Marina camera and weather station to the website so you can check out the weather before you visit. Other District related information has also been added.

The most exciting addition to District services is the rural Post Office boxes in the lobby and the neighborhood boxes on Spalding Road. This service is free! Come see us if you are interested in a box! Our focus is to clean up Spalding and make it look inviting for folks to visit. We are also creating an ordinance that will allow us to focus on weed abatement so as to prevent fires.

On July 2 – 5 from noon to 4 p.m., the District in coordination with Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority, C&S Waste, the Fire Safe Council and Cal Fire will be having \$1/truck load green waste dump at the transfer station. Please continue to burn your pine needles while the fire hazard is low or when permits are available. Bring whatever green waste you have left after the fire permits have expired to this event. This is a great opportunity to clean up properties and make them fire safe at the same time!
