The selected candidate will fulfill the remaining term of the open Board seat which expires on December 1, 2026.***

The Spalding Community Services District (SCSD), for many years has had the pleasure of serving its customers by providing Sewer, Fire, and Recreation Services. SCSD is a governmental organization supported by a five-member elected Board of Directors which sets and upholds SCSD ordinances and policies. The five-member Board of Directors is elected by voters registered within the District or appointed to fulfill a term of Board seat vacancy. The Board meets at regularly scheduled meetings once a month and may hold special meetings that are independent of regular meetings. Meetings last between 2-3 hours, and it is required of Board members to read meeting packet documentation prior to meeting.

The Board of SCSD is highly active supporting the needs of the District and community. Board members will serve on an ad-hoc committee of their choice or as needed. Committee time is in addition to attending required meetings. Other Board member requirements include:

- Ethics Training, per CA AB1234
- Sexual Harassment Training, per CA AB1825
- Annual Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) reporting per the California Fair Political Practices
