I hope everyone is having a great start to their summer! Rainfall has been good at Eagle Lake this year. As of June 20, 2015, we have had 16" of rain or 76% of normal rainfall for the year. That doesn't mean that Eagle Lake has gotten any higher. Dr. Bateson measured the lake a couple of weeks ago and the lake is about a foot above its lowest recorded level. We really need the thunderstorms to continue throughout the summer to maintain current levels.

Our next Pancake Breakfasts will be July 5! Please help support the function of the Fire Department by attending these events. All the volunteers are renewing their firefighter endorsements on their driver's licenses and updating their training for CPR and first aid. We continue to respond to many medical calls and all of our equipment is fully maintained and ready to respond!

Our new solar system has been up and functional since January 12, 2015. As of June, it is paying for 100% of the electricity for the Community Hall, Fire Department, Administrative Offices and Maintenance building. The Board has committed to paying the Sewer fund back \$4,800 per year to pay back the cost of building the system. It will be paid off in eight years.
